

**AZ GAME & FISH TRAINING PERMITS FOR
PINE HILL/RED TANK & ROBBINS BUTTE & DUGAS ROAD
(Updated July 2010)**

If you intend to do any field training that involves releasing game birds, the State of Arizona Game & Fish Department requires you to carry an AZ Game & Fish Field Training Permit. It doesn't matter if the birds will be shot or not. The key is whether birds will be involved during your training session.

Each person in the household that will be involved in training needs their own permit. The permits are valid for 1 year from date of issue and are area specific.

Submit permit applications for all 3 training areas so you are prepared to train at all locations.

FIRST TIME APPLICANTS –

- **“Department ID Number” –**
 - **Call 480-981-9400** (AZ G&F Mesa Office)
 - **Request a new Department ID Number.**
 - **Write** that number on **all 3** permit applications.
 - **See “Everyone” section below.**

REPEAT APPLICANTS –

- **“Department ID Number” –**
 - **Your Number** is in the upper right corner of past permit.
 - **Write** it on **all 3** permit applications.
 - If you have **multiple** Department Id Numbers – **only use one.**
 - Attach a note listing the other numbers and ask that they be closed.
 - **See “Everyone” section below.**

EVERYONE –

- **TRAINING PERMITS ARE FREE.**
- **COMPLETE all 3** permit application forms.
- Mail forms to address at top of form. **THE FORMS ARE MAILED TO SEPARATE ADDRESSES.**
- **WHEN YOU GET THE PERMITS** – Look for the Department ID Number in the upper right corner of the permits. Keep this number for next year's permitting process.
- **CARRY THE PERMITS** with you when you do field training.
